Incredible: we were not able to make any Raksha Mancham News between November 1992 and February 1994 and we now release Raksha Mancham News # 5 when the Raksha Mancham News # 4 was out less than two months ago...!!!

The reason is very simple: We succeeded!!! The parliamentary resolution we wrote on Tibet and which we submitted through the efficient support of Mr. Simons, Deputee at the Belgian Parliament and President of the Inter-Group on Tibet, to the Belgian Parliament was finally voted on the 29.O3.1994.

We completed the recordings of "Ghazels" late March. We still intend to release the Compact-Disc early May. The recordings of 1 200 000 Dead Tibetans had been postponed to July.
